Use : Bedding and border
Seeds count : 3300 s/g, 92000 s/oz
Sowing : January for a summer flowering, in June-July to flower the following year
Germination : 12°C / 54°F in 7-14 days
Transplanting : 4 weeks after sowing in 10 cm / 4 in. pots or packs
