Use : Bedding, rockery, ground cover, pots

Colours : Mixture of blue, rose and white flowers

Seeds count : 700 s/g, 20000 s/oz

Sowing : February-March for a spring flowering

First half of May for an autumn flowering

Germination : 18°C / 64°F in 7-14 days

Transplanting : After 6 weeks

Pots or packs Growing : at 12-15°C / 54-59°F

Advice : Thrives in all soil types. Prefers full sun or half shade.

Height : 18 cm / 7 in.

Spread : 10 cm / 4 in.

USDA hardiness zone : 3-4
